### General Injection Information

- The injection procedure is covered by Alberta Health Care; however, the cost of injection products are not. A receipt will be provided to you following your injection that may then be submitted to your private insurance plan when applicable.
- It is common to experience minor aching at your injection site following your procedure
- Injections are performed in a sterile manner; however, all types of injections have a small risk for infection (approximately 1 in 10,000). Signs of infection include localized redness, warmth and pain at the injection site +/- fever. Please contact your physician immediately or seek urgent medical attention if you develop signs of infection.
- Additional risks from injections are rare but may include allergic reaction, bleeding, nerve damage and/or syncope (fainting). Please notify your physician ahead of time if you have previously fainted due to a medical procedure.
